Mayor Walt Stanckiewicz will be handing over the “Property Deed” on Tuesday, August 9th at 9:30am to Habitat for Humanity San Bernardino Area. Accepting the deed will be Philip Sousa, Habitat Board President and MaryRose Wallace, Habitat Executive Director.

Habitat for Humanity will then host two Homeowner Orientations for future applicants to receive a Habitat home. The orientations will take place in the Community Room at the Grand Terrace Civic Center (22795 Barton Road) on August 24th at 7pm and August 27th at 10am.
